Professor Dr.-Ing. Rolf Eligehausen studied structural engineering at the Technical University of Braunschweig and received his Doctor of Engineering from the University of Stuttgart in 1979. After completing his doctorate, he spent two years as a research engineer at the University of California, Berkeley. In 1984 he was appointed professor of fastening technique at the University of Stuttgart. He is a member of numerous national and international committees in the field of fastening technique and reinforced concrete including the European Organization for Technical Approvals (EOTA) Working Group "Fasteners" and the American Concrete Institute (ACI) committees 349 (Nuclear), 355 (Anchorage) and 408 (Bond). Additionally, he is chairman of the International Federation for Structural Concrete (fib) Special Activity Group "Fastening to Concrete and Masonry" and the European Committee for Standardization (CEN) Working Group "Design of Fastenings for Use in Concrete". He has authored or co-authored more than 250 papers and two textbooks.
